# Continuing Education Credits

In Colorado, anyone engaged in the business of applying or supervising the use of pesticides in exchange for payment is required to be licensed as a Commercial Pesticide Applicator by the Colorado Department of Agriculture (CDA). Private pesticide applicators must be licensed by the CDA before they may purchase or apply restricted use pesticides on their own lands.

The Western Colorado Pest Management Workshop is conducted annually to provide all licensed pesticide applicators the opportunity to receive the continuing education credits required to maintain their license with CDA.

This program is for pesticide applicators who are already licensed. If you do not have a current pesticide applicators license, you must take a test and be licensed with the CDA before continuing education credits can be issued.

The Wednesday morning program meets all continuing education credit requirements for private pesticide applicators. This session fulfills core categories for commercial pesticide applicators, who are required to attend additional one-hour sessions in each category for which they are licensed.

Continuing education credits are also available for commercial pesticide applicators licensed in UT, NM and WY. If other state credits are needed please contact us, and we will try to make arrangements. ASA/SSSA Certified Crop Advisors can receive continuing education credits for selected presentations.

# Technician Training Credits

Employees of commercial, limited commercial or public applicators can receive up to 12 1/2 hours of verified technician classroom/instructional training credits in many required categories. Individuals who receive technician training credits can register at the \$50 rate.
